The exam is a multiple-choice test. There will be 25 questions, with 4 possible answers to each question (ABCD). Only one of the answers is correct. Additionally, there will be option E if you prefer not to provide your answer to the particular question.

Correct answer will earn you 2 points, incorrect answer will cost you 0.5 points (that is, half a point). If you decide not to answer the question (option E), you will score 0 points. There is no threshold for passing the exam. To pass the course, you must score at least 50 points combined from the exam + individual assignment + presentation + points from seminars.

Open book policy is in place. This means that you can use any books or printed materials in general (including my slides). You are, however not allowed to use your phones/tablets/computers etc.

Most (if not all) students will finish the exam within 60 minutes, but if you need more time, you can take as much as you need. Your grades will appear in AIS system once your assignment is evaluated also.
