Information about the final exam

The exam is a multiple-choice test. There will be 25 questions, with 4 possible answers to each question (ABCD). Only one of the answers is correct. Correct answer will earn you 2 points, incorrect answer will cost you 0.5 points (that is, half a point). There is no threshold for passing the exam. To pass the course, you must score at least 50 points combined from the exam + individual assignment + presentations + points from lectures and seminars.

Open book policy is in place. This means that you can use any books or printed materials in general (including my slides). You are, however not allowed to use your phones/tablets, internet etc.

Most (if not all) students will finish the exam within 60 minutes. Your grades will appear in AIS system once your assignment is evaluated also.
